Entry Criteria

WSP Lincolne Scott

Sustainability Leadership Award

The *WSP Lincolne Scott* Sustainability Leadership Award is open to large businesses, small to medium enterprises, government agencies and non-government organisations.

It is designed to reward those organisations that demonstrate outstanding leadership in adopting practices that position environmental and social performance as priority areas of corporate responsibility and performance, alongside financial results. It acknowledges those organisations that understand their broader societal responsibilities and their potential influence within the community to foster sustainability, as well as with their own supply chains.

Specifically, the Award recognises:

- the extent to which sustainability principles and practices have been formally integrated within and throughout the organisation's strategic planning, decision making processes and core business operations;
- the organisation's externally verified environmental, social and economic outcomes across all business areas and its transparent public reporting of those outcomes (a formal Sustainability Report is not a prerequisite);
- the organisation's commitment to incorporating sustainability principles and practices throughout its supply chain; and
- innovative approaches to embedding sustainability throughout the organisation, in addition to innovations that have arisen as a result of application of sustainability "thinking" to the organisation's business processes and activities.

Applications must provide evidence of demonstrated business performance outcomes around all dimensions of sustainability (i.e. environment, social, cultural, economic, governance) and the management structures and processes that have directly influenced these outcomes.

Method of Entry:

Entries must be submitted in hard copy print format, and may include photographic, CD or DVD evidence to illustrate and describe the project, person or initiative. Multiple entries are acceptable. However, to be eligible for judging, an official entry form and the appropriate entry fee must accompany each individual category entered.

A nomination form for the United Nations Association of Australia World Environment Day Awards 2010 is attached below. Please read the instructions below, complete the Nomination Form and attach it to the front of your entry. **Electronic submissions will not be accepted.**

Nomination Checklist

Before mailing your nomination please check you have enclosed the following documents for each individual entry.

1. A completed Nomination Form for each award for which you have nominated.
2. Three hard copies of a typed submission, no longer than 2,000 words, which covers the entry criteria for each award entered.
3. Three hard copies of a one page synopsis summarising your entry.
4. A selection of three colour or black/white photographs relating to the environmental project and/or people involved in the project. (These items will not be returned, but arrangements can be made to collect them from our office)
5. Any media materials (CD/DVD/ Print article) relevant to your entry.
6. Your entry fee Cheque made out to: "United Nations Association of Australia, Victoria", if you have not already paid by Visa or MasterCard on your nomination form.

If you are entering the Media/Environmental Reporting Award category the date and publication/program in which the piece was published, or went to air, must be specified. The following materials must also be provided:

7(a). Print:

Three copies of the published article for each award entered. (These can be good quality photocopies instead of originals).

7(b). Radio

One CD of the program for each award entered.

7(c). Television

One DVD of the program for each award entered.
